School Council Elections

If you are considering nominating for the 2020 School Council, please remember that nominations must be in by 4.00pm next Tuesday 25th February. Nomination forms are available from the main office.

Administration of Medication

Schools are not allowed to administer any medications, creams or sprays unless we have written medical practitioner or parent approval to do so. If your child requires medication - short, medium or long term, we ask that you complete the Medication Administration Forms that are available on the school website under Parents/First Aid. There is one form for short-term medication (1-5 days) and another for longer term. You can print these off and bring them in to school with any medication your child requires. All medication is required to be delivered and collected by adults only, students are not permitted to carry medication.

National Ride to School Day

The 2020 National Ride to School Day will take place on Friday 13th March. Students can ride, scoot or skate to school on this day and Mr West and I will be out front near the school crossing that morning giving out 'spooky stickers' – it is Friday 13th remember!

Years 4 – 6 Swimming Lessons

There is currently an expression of interest on Compass (via Insights) looking for students in Years 4 to 6 who might need additional swimming lessons to be able to complete their Victorian Water Safety Certificate. We are offering subsidised swimming lessons over a period of 10 days in March at the Gisborne Pool. Once I know how many students are interested in attending I can work out the cost. It is likely to be around \$60 -\$70 for the 10 lessons which includes transport, entry and swimming lessons by an instructor. Please check Compass Insights (found under the Community icon).

School Sport Victoria Trials 2020

School Sport Victoria will once again be offering the opportunity for students with emerging talent from New Gisborne Primary School to register for trials for School Sport Victoria Team Vic State Teams in 2020.

Registrations are open and will remain open until Sunday 1st March, 2020 for Boys Australian Rules Football, Netball, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, and Boys Football (Soccer). The trials are for Years 5 & 6 students. If your child is in Year 4 and wishes to try out, **please see us first** as Year 4 students are very rarely chosen for SSV State teams (none from our district in 20 years). Most Team Vic teams are comprised of Year 6 students. Once again, it's rare for Year 5 students to make these teams, unless they're exceptionally talented in their chosen sport. There are over 15 sports to choose from. Visit the SSV website if you wish to view these sports. Cricket for boys and girls requires a separate nomination so please come and see us if you require information about trialling.

Please note: Trials are **NOT** Come 'n' Try opportunities. They are a process for selecting a Team Vic State Team to represent the State at School Sport Australia Championships. Please see us if you need clarification of the standard your child needs to be at to compete at these trials.

Minor changes to the process for 2020 are:

- a. 12 Years and Under Girls Australian Rules Football will be offered. All nominees will go direct to State Trials.
- b. 12 Years and Under Girls Football (Soccer) will not be required to go through stages of selection. All nominees will go direct to State Trials.

You must see us before completing the registration process as there are limited positions for each sport in our District and if we have too many applicants from our school, I will need to communicate with the seven other district coordinators to decide which students meet the criteria.

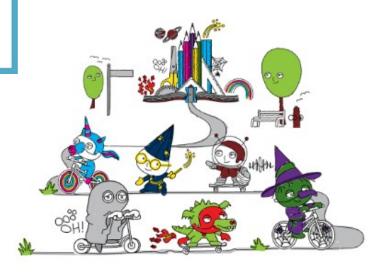

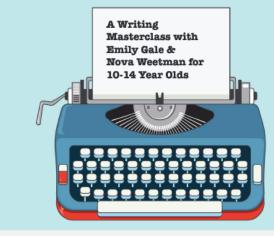
